MESSA A FUOCO LAB

What does it mean to migrate or be a migrant today?

What really defines this experience?

Registration is now open for participation in the **entirely free** MESSA A FUOCO LAB, conceived by the youth association KINORUMORE, and aimed at first- and second-generation migrants who want to tell their own story, fragments of their daily lives, trying to return the complex picture of the migration phenomenon.

A workshop funded by Lazio Crea and Vitamina G where you will be given free of charge the professional tools to make a short documentary as an author and narrate your experience and your view of the world.

LAB STRUCTURE

- The workshop will take place every Saturday afternoon (four hours) for two months. This first phase will be dedicated to learning narrative and directing techniques. Participants will be supervised by tutors and experts in the field. Lectures, tutorials and cineforums to develop their narrative idea and acquire professional skills for the making of the final documentary.
- Upon completion of the first phase of the workshop, there will be two intensive weekends dedicated to production and filming. In this phase, each participant, with the support of the tutors, will be able to make their own short documentary according to their authorial vision. The shooting days may vary according to the needs of each project.

- The footage of each of the short documentaries will be entrusted to a professional editor who, supported by the author, will finalize the work.
- The final product will be presented at major film festivals.

WHERE AND WHEN

The workshop will take place in **Rome** in **September and October** at the Latte Creative space, Città dell'Altra Economia. Hours of work will be subject to change in accordance with the needs of participants, production, development of the overall work experience. Final confirmation will take place no later than the date of publication of the selections.

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

The workshop is aimed at girls and boys living in Rome, included in an age range of **18-35** years, from foreign countries and currently residing in Italy, foreign students, second-generation Italians.

A **minimum knowledge of Italian** is also required (English and French will be used as supporting languages if needed).

In compliance with these requirements, all those who are willing to acquire skills in documentary filmmaking as a professional tool and as a language capable of providing a narrative, creative, expressive tool are eligible.

A maximum of **eight participants** will be selected.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Participants should submit the following materials via **online format** (<u>paragraph below</u>):

A) Short biography of the author (no more than one page, also in English or French).

- B) A free story of a documentary nature that you would like to tell taken from your daily life or experience, if possible (one page maximum).
- C) Optional: you may send up to a maximum of **five photos** of your choice.

DEADLINE AND REGISTRATION

The deadline for entry is August 15, 2023.

PUBLICATION OF THIS INITIATIVE

The KINORUMORE youth association was created together with the **Messa A Fuoco Lab** project, a winning project of the VitaminaG call for proposals under the GenerAzioniGiovani.it program funded by the Youth Policies of the Lazio Region with the support of the Department of Youth.

The Kinorumore youth association is also supported by other local organizations such as Baobab, Matemù, Refugees Welcome, Latte Creative and Coloriage.

By submitting the required documents, the applicant automatically manifests his/her willingness to participate in the workshop by declaring and guaranteeing:
